

## California University of Pennsylvania Hazing Report for the years 2017 to 2021

### 2017:

4/12/17 Kappa Alpha Psi and Krimson Kourt Inc. Accused by third party of hazing involving verbal abuse, eating expired food and paddling of Krimson Kourt members. Allegations unfounded. National headquarters notified. Krimson Kourt national assisted in the investigation.

### 2018:

4/16/2018 Phi Gamma Delta accused of hazing. Third party report of new members being Sleep deprived and emotionally abused. Allegations unfounded. National headquarters notified.

### 2019:

5/2/2019 Alpha Phi Omega investigation has been completed regarding report being received at end of spring semester. Third party report of new members being required to wear and show "pledge pins", to memorize and perform a selected sonnet and to walk through a course while blindfolded. The organization was found not responsible for hazing after the investigation. University personnel worked with the members and advisor to address and correct concerns that lead to the allegations.

Alpha Sigma Tau – Allegations of hazing by anonymous third party investigated by National Headquarters and University. Allegation included new members not being allowed to wear stitched letters, being required to complete library hours and attend workshops, being required to wear pins, being required to participate in line ups where derogatory comments were directed towards them and were given parameters for alcohol consumption. Following investigation, the chapter was found responsible for hazing due to allegations of limiting access to stitched letters and requiring library hours and workshop attendance were substantiated. The other allegations were not substantiated. The chapter was placed on University Probation through March 13, 2020 and required to complete additional educational activities by National Headquarters.

### 2020:

No hazing issues reported for the year 2020.

**2021:** No issues reported to date
