Virtual Desktops and Applications are hosted within the University data center, and are remotely accessible by users. The University provides a virtual desktop infrastructure (VDI) to enable secure remote access.

VDI provides an environment for virtual computing systems that can run required software for classes as well as off campus use of software that is licensed through the University.
